DIRECTIONS TO BLUE ROCK SPRINGS PARK

From I-80 heading North toward Sacramento

take the Columbus Parkway exit -follow the roadway until it merges with Columbus Parkway. Continue on Columbus Parkway for approximately 2 miles. The park is located on the north (left-hand) side of the road.

From I-80 heading South toward San Francisco

take the Columbus Parkway/San Rafael Hwy 37 exit. Follow signs to Columbus Parkway. The Roadway will narrow and turn left under I-80. The road then becomes Columbus Parkway. Continue for approximately 2 miles. Park is located on the north (left-hand) side of the road.

From Marin and Sonoma County

take the CA-37 East towards Vallejo / Napa. Take the Columbus Parkway exit. Follow signs to Columbus Parkway crossing the I-80. The road then becomes Columbus Parkway. Continue for approximately 2 miles. Park is located on the north (left-hand) side of the road.

BLUE ROCK SPRINGS PARK is a historic site with large picnic areas with BBQ's, open turf play areas, children's play equipment, a small lake and island with ducks and peacocks, off street parking and restrooms. A hiking trail provides access to the ridge of the Sulfur Springs Mountain for spectacular views of Vallejo and the Napa River.

The Greater Vallejo Recreation District does not usually allow dogs in this beautiful park, however, this is the second year they have made special allowances for our working dogs to compete here. We ask that owners and handlers be extra judicious in picking up after their dogs and keeping their dogs on leash or in pens when not competing. We hope to be invited back again!

PARKING: Please note that there is a \$4 parking fee per day at this site.
